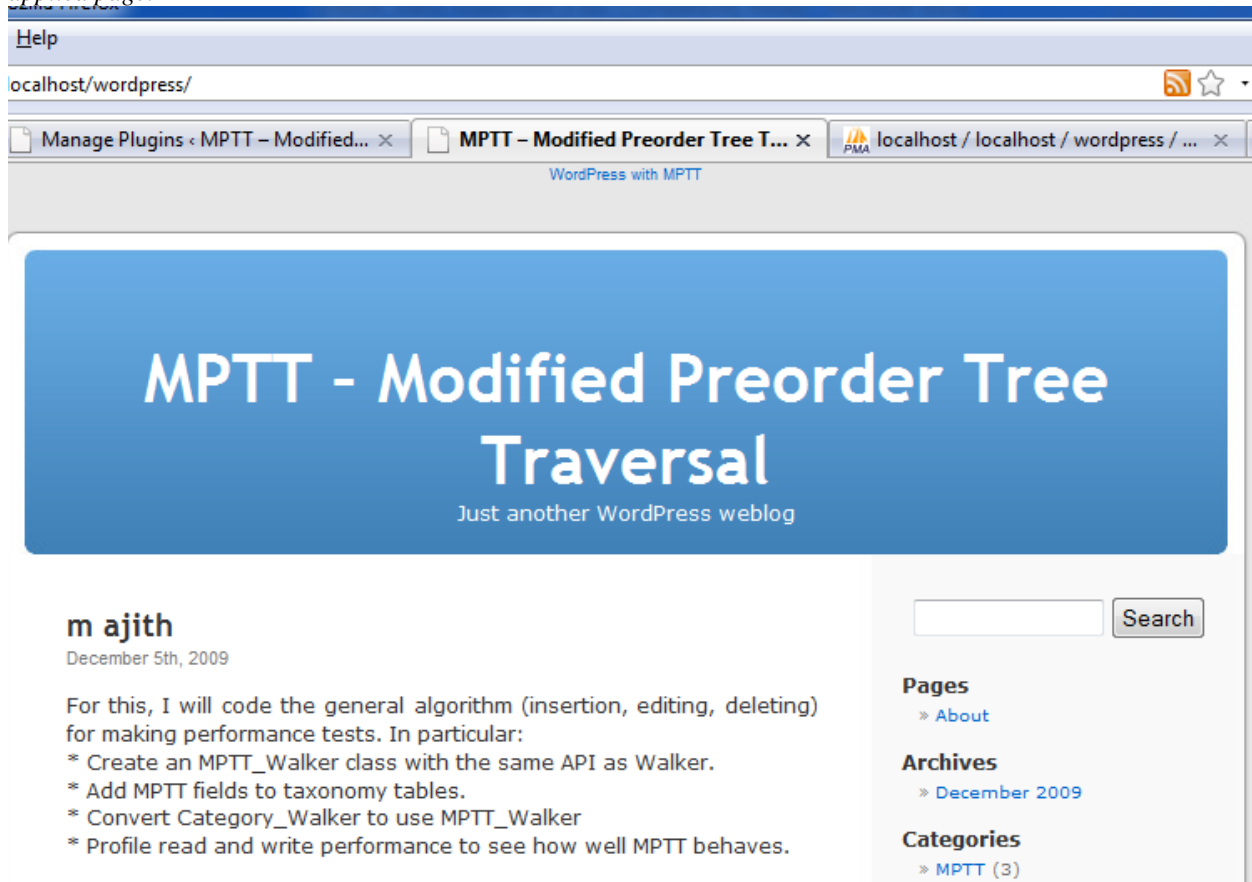

- Working with Dreamweaver.

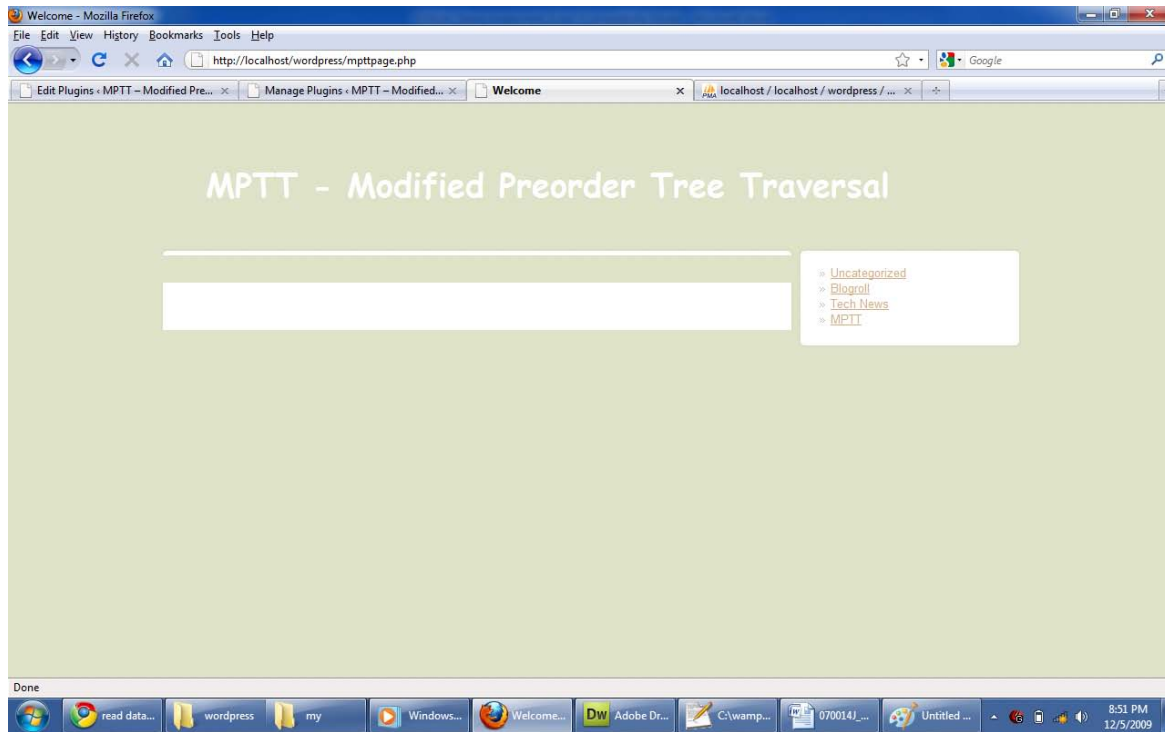

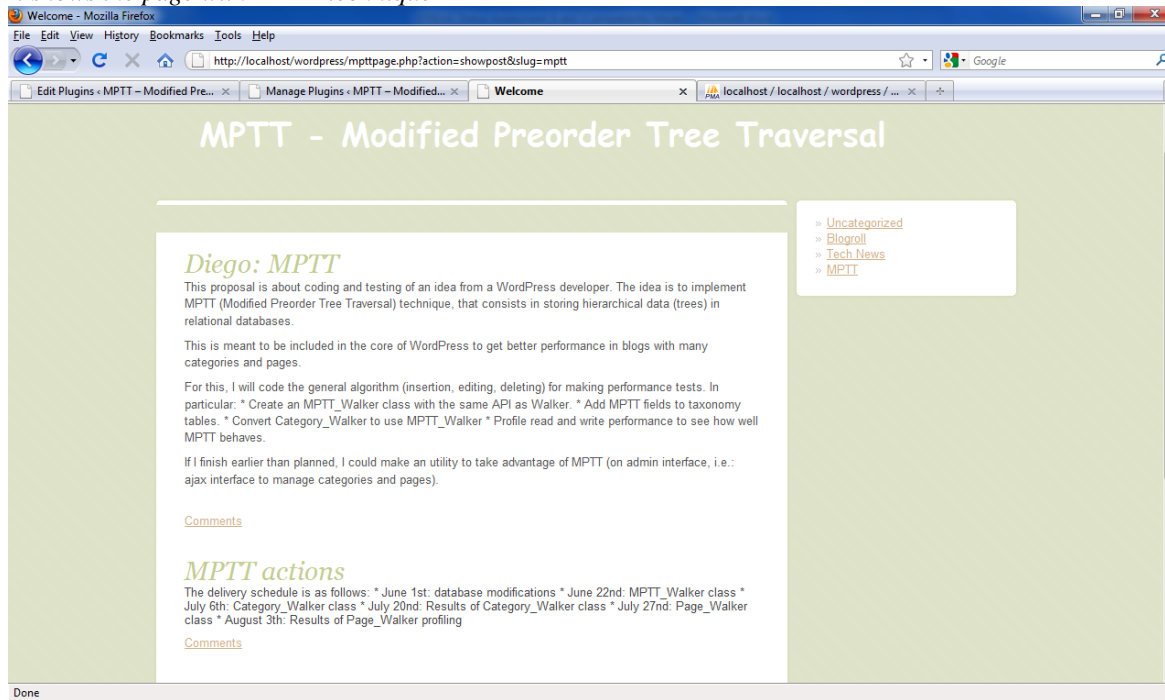

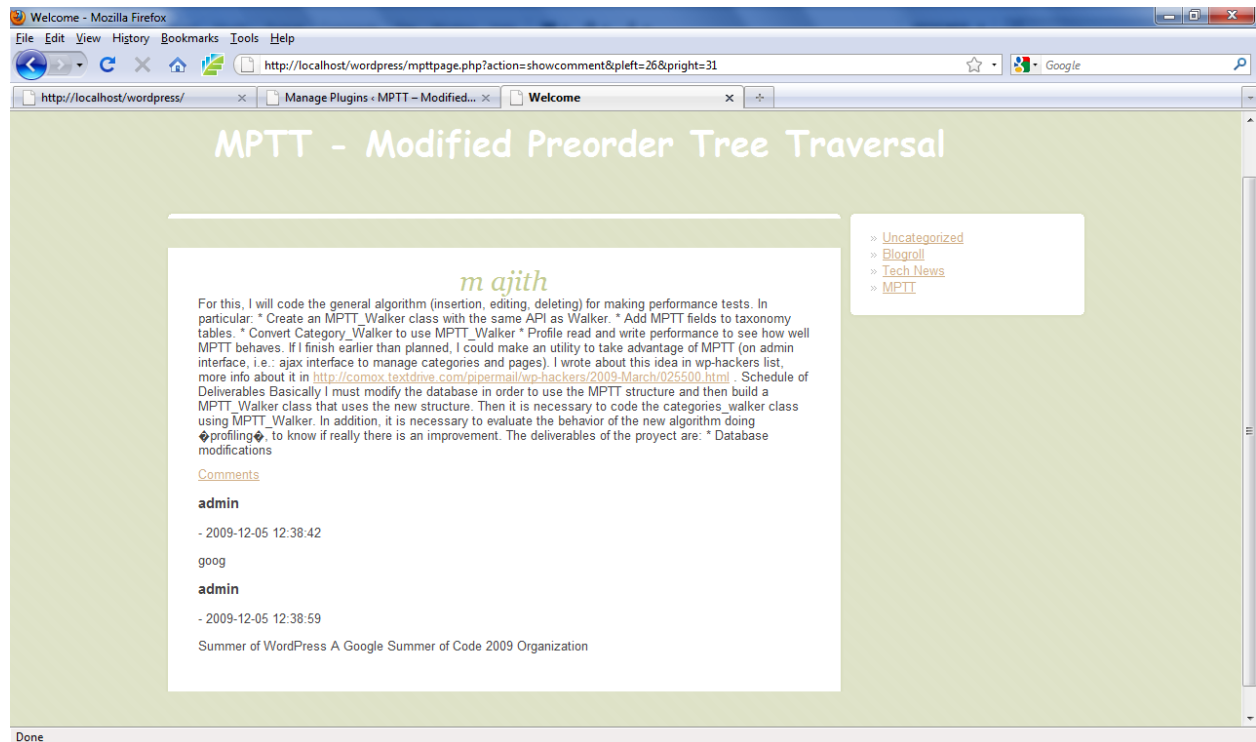
Front page with MPTT technique.
